What is Epiphany?

Epiphany is on January 6th, which is twelve days after Christmas. This is the amount of time that spans the birth of Jesus, and according to tradition when the magi visited Mary, Joseph, and their child. Epiphany doesn't always fall on a Sunday, so the Church celebrates it on the nearest Sunday (5th January, 2025) called "Epiphany Sunday".

The Greek word *epiphany* simply means "to reveal" or "to make manifest." It was the name given by early Christians to celebrate the birth of Jesus, the revelation of God's love to the world (<u>John 3:16</u>). An annual festival would follow to celebrate and recognize that Jesus, the Son of God, reveals God's plan to save the world.
